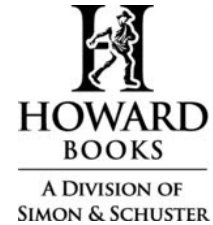

We've all heard of the bucket list, that fabled tally of things we want to accomplish before our lives are over. Sometimes those lists include *people*, those celebrities, athletes, musicians and others we hope to someday meet. But what if, instead of creating a list of specific names, we let God invite people into our lives according to His will? In her latest book, *God's Guest List* (Howard Books, November 2010, ISBN: 9781439108963, \$23.00), celebrated author Debbie Macomber explores that very question.

Macomber writes that she once had such a list, a ballot of 30 people she wanted to meet. In the end, she did meet them—but found that some weren't at all who she had hoped they'd be. After a few of these disconcerting exchanges, Macomber turned to God, who showed Macomber her error: it was God who should make up that list, not her. So Macomber did as instructed; she replaced her list of names with empty slots and waited to see whom God would choose to fill the spaces. "From then on," Macomber writes, "I've looked deeply into each face I meet."

Macomber shares this poignant, eye-opening exercise in *God's Guest List*. One of today's leading voices in women's fiction, Macomber is a New York *Times* best-selling author with more than 140 million books in print. With her "God-given talent" for storytelling, Macomber is excited to share her story and discuss how readers might learn to discover God's guest list for their own lives through the personal anecdotes, breathtaking true stories, passages of scripture and advice she shares in *God's Guest List*, which include:

- How to cultivate the wisdom to recognize wise people God has placed in our paths
- Ways to become God's invited guest on someone *else's* list
- Why some friends appear for a season, some for a reason, and how to recognize those in need
- How to find the gifts in even the most prickly person—and how to avoid becoming the prickly person on someone else's list
- Learning to recognize the gifts left to us by those who have passed on, and ways you can leave footprints of faith, hope, nurturing and love behind for others to find
- Understanding that even brief romantic relationships influence our lives and why it's important to examine your influence on your partner or spouse
- The surprising, and sometimes hidden, ways that professional relationships can influence our lives, and how to help others as they reach for their own goals and dreams
